Family Distance Learning Suggestions



Suggestions that will strengthen home-school connections and support School connectivity.

Establish routines and expectation—It is important to develop good habits from the start. Create a flexible routine and talk about how it's working over time. Chunk your days into predictable segments. Help students get up, get dressed and ready to learn at a reasonable time. Everybody make your bed! Keep normal bedtime routines, including normal rules for digital devices. Adjust schedules to meet everyone's needs, but don't default to staying up late and sleeping in.
